Paint colours in the General Zone should reflect the warm earthy tones evident in traditional Australian Homesteads as well as soft pastels of New Norcia which were also popular during the Spanish Revival period. Hues are warmer in tone and diverse in colour range to promote individual taste. Warm greys and beiges are also acceptable. Darker colours may be incorporated as a contrasting highlight however must be selected in keeping with the above examples. Dark charcoals and blues as well as overly bright or primary colours may not be acceptable.
